She is still loves any toys that squeek and likes to try to put a couple toys in her mouth at the same time. When it is time to go outside and go potty, Maggie likes to find a toy to carry outside with her before she heads out the door. This smart blond definitely has lots of personality.



July 2, 2010

Maggie Mae had surgery on June 2nd to stabilize her left back knee ligament tear. At her four week checkup, the vet said she was doing great. He recommended that she not be put up for adoption for another 1 1/2 to 2 months until she recuperates further and can be more active. She is now allowed on very short walks and will build from there as tolerated. He also said she only needs to lose about another 5 or 6 pounds to be at her ideal weight.



Maggie Mae's completely trusts people even through the entire surgery process which shows that her previous owner must have been gentle and kind to her.

She has a cute and determined personality. She is fun to just watch. Maggie Mae enjoys squeaky toys and uses toys to keep herself entertained during her recovery. She gets along well with all the dogs in the foster home and the 9 month old puppy is her favorite. She is young at heart. She has even learned to ignore the cats since arriving here.

June 17, 2010

Maggie Mae had surgery on June 2nd to stabilize her left back knee ligament tear. Her incision is healing nicely and she is doing very well. She must stay on reduced activity for 8 weeks. She absolutely loves playing with squeaky toys and that helps to pass the time while she is recuperating. She really enjoys the company of our 8 month old puppy and he can't wait for her to be able to play again. She is a sweetie pie and loves to be petted and by our side.



May 24, 2010



Maggie Mae is going to have surgery on June 2nd to stabilize her left back knee. She continues to do very well at her foster home and has lost some needed weight. She loves all types of squeaky toys and loves playing with her "brothers" - especially the 8 month old puppy.

Because she enjoys toys as much as she does and being with people, I expect her to do well post operative. She has a great personality and is always very happy. Maggie does not need to be kenneled because she behaves well when left loose in the house.



May 1, 2010

"My name is Maggie Mae. I am 7 ½ years old and I am a very happy and sometimes silly girl. I really enjoy playing with soft squeaky toys, going for short walks, and playing with other goldens. I like to bark and growl at the cats in my foster home but I do not do anything more to them. My next home will have to tolerate this quirky behavior or not have any cats.

She takes glucosamine daily for joint health.
