On Saturday, Kenzie weighed in at 81.6 pounds. She's down to 50% of her weight loss goal. We gave her exercise in the house as it's still too hot outside. She usually has the run of the house. She sleeps in her bed, on the futon or on the floor in the bedrooms. In the evening, she's content to lay in the living room at our feet. In the morning, she's usually content to wait until we get up.

August 2, 2010

Kenzie is improving every day. She has such a sunny disposition and is a joy to have around. She saw the vet again. This vet had never seen her before and is sure she doesn't have a thyroid problem. As a matter of fact, she lost another 2.5 pounds and is becoming more active. The heat takes a toll on all of us and she refuses to chase a ball outside. We have a long hall in the house so we wear her out inside. My wife makes her go up and down the basement stairs with her! So we hope we can find her forever home very soon.

July 16, 2010

The vet visit on Tuesday is encouraging. She only lost a pound so she is on a more strict diet. The vet says a pound a week weight loss going forward is adequate. She (the vet) wants to be cautious on the thyroid issue yet and see how the diet goes. Meanwhile, Kenzie is enjoying life. She is showing occasional bursts of energy and is enjoying fetch even in this heat but the fetch game usually ends as a game of keep-away when she tires! She is showing her sweet, fun loving personality more every day. She just doesn't have any faults or bad habits. She loves being brushed and doesn't object to having us trim her nails or the hair on her feet.

July 11, 2010



Kenzie is as sweet as they come! She settled in with us after a couple of days. The vet says her hips are perfect and everything checks out except for her weight. She is on a diet and has another visit to the vet on July 13 to check her weight and then maybe a thyroid test. She is living up to her evaluation and then some. She loves to ride and gets along with everyone and is very docile. Her thyroid could be a factor in this though. She is a joy to have around. She loves to play tug of war with her toys and fetch them as well. She tires quickly though. In the morning she makes a lot of noise, growling and whining as she brings a toy to the side of the bed. After a few

hugs and pets, she usually goes back to sleep. Sometimes she wants to be fed. She wants everyone in bed by 10PM however. She walks well on a leash but pulls to the side of the road and sniffs. We'll provide more information after the vet visit.
