Two large hot spots were found behind the mats in the back of his ears, and his nails were 2 inches long.

He was taken to the Vet early the next morning. He has two ear infections and the two hot spots behind his ears are now healing very well. He has a second Vet appt for his vaccinations. Due to his infected ears, the Vet did not want to stress him to much. The Vet estimated Gunner was 25 to 30 pounds overweight.

It does not appear he has had any formal training so we are working on heeling, sits, downs and stays. He had pulled really hard on the leash, but we are working on this and he has gotten much better. At times he heels like a pro. He seems to have a short attention span. Does what is asked but is easily distracted. He just wants to love everyone. Has perfect house manners. He is loved by everyone he meets.
