He ate a lot the first evening I had him. I made him a special homemade diet tonight since he didn't want to eat the dry food at the shelter, or here. He scarfs up three portions a day. I think he just lost weight from being so sad at the shelter. As loving as he is, it may well be that he just had a broken heart. :-(He does the Golden lean, the nose bump under your arm, and loves his butt scratched. He has a lot of scabs on his skin and some missing hair. but that could be from the severe flea issues he had when he came into the shelter. It could just be a reaction to the infestation. He doesn't look like the typical allergy dog at all.

He is even going outside to go potty on his own and seems to be potty trained! We're going to the vet tomorrow to get him fixed now that he has put on weight and doesn't have the diarrhea issue. We'll do bloodwork on him just to be sure there is no other reason he lost weight. He is a happy healthy boy that seems so thrilled to have a human to love again. This fella will make the perfect Golden for someone!
